The essence of aesthetic dentistry is meeting the expectations of your patients. It doesn't matter if the restorative outcome impresses you, your staff, your colleagues or even passes accreditation with the AACD. It has to impress the patient or you have lost. Dr. Montgomery has maintained a full time cosmetic oriented family practice since 1986 in Woodbury, Minnesota and has lectured several times on functional based esthetic dentistry for local dental organizations.
